

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LEASK NO. 464

BYLAW NO. 4 /2021

A Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Leask No. 464, in the Province of Saskatchewan to amend Bylaw 1/2020 known as the Official Community Plan under subsection 29(2) of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Leask No. 464 in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting hereby enacts that Bylaw 1/2020 known as the Official Community Plan be amended as follows:

1. **Section 3.8, Lakeshore Development, is amended by repealing and replacing section 3.8.2(l) with the following:**
 - l) To limit future subdivisions along Martins, Emerald, D’Amour and Lac La Peche Lake.
2. **Section 3.8, Lakeshore Development, is amended by repealing and replacing section 3.8.3(h) with the following:**
 - h) To avoid issues from overdevelopment and overcrowding, no further subdivisions, excluding boundary adjustments and lot consolidations that comply with the Zoning Bylaw regulations, shall occur surrounding Martins, Emerald, D’Amour and Lac La Peche Lake. The area in which further subdivision is not supported is identified on the Future Land Use Map.
3. **The Future Land Use Map attached to and forming part of the Official Community Plan is amended by removing the “No Further Subdivision” area from all land surrounding Iroquois Lake and shown within the bold dashed line on the maps below.**



4. **This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the date it is approved by the Minister of Government Relations.**
