- COVID concern, population density has increased incredibly due to COVID; day users have increased: theory due to COVID - noise, traffic, garbage has increased
- Summer 2021 lake traffic was crazy; can't stop day use, but we can't open up for more development;
- Lake can't sustain the additional population

Concerns of conflict of interest should be watched carefully
