NOTICE TO ALL CAMPGROUNDS

Please be aware development permits are required for any and all construction, including but not limited to decks and sheds.

NOTICE TO ALL DEVELOPMENTS

Campgrounds are permitted only on lands Zoned Resort Commercial. Other Zones require Residential Single Detached Dwellings. At present only one Recreation Vehicle is allowed on a lot during construction of such dwelling.



Tree/Brush Removal

The RM has a policy for the reimbursement of tree/brush removal for road allowances.

Pre-approval is necessary for payment of \$400 per 1/2 mile.
