## 1.0 Purpose

To establish criteria for naming roads and paying for the cost of signage.

## 2.0 Policy Parameters

1. The proponent who wishes to have a sign erected shall make application to Council requesting the road sign inclusive of name of road and location of erection of the sign. The sign shall measure 6 inches x 30 inches.
2. The name given to a road shall reflect;
  - a. The name commonly given to a road;
  - b. The geographical area; or
  - c. Recognition of a pioneer
3. Once Council agrees in principal to name a road, a letter shall be sent to owners of property adjacent to the road advising of such intention and giving any interested party an opportunity to comment.
4. The proponent of a road naming shall pay for all costs incurred by the Municipality in advertising the proposal and erecting the sign; if the sign requires replacement, the Municipality will only provide one replacement sign and the proponent will be required to pay for additional signs replacements.
5. Where a road intersects a Provincial Highway the road name sign shall be erected by Sask. Highways and Transportation in accordance with their procedures and policies. Where a road does not intersect a Provincial Highway, the Municipality shall erect signs where a said road intersects a major grid road.
