Your new park board has been very busy coming up to speed with a variety of board matters, and the park operations are going smoothly thanks to our excellent staff. The board is now proceeding with reviewing and completing a variety of importance governance documents and we are looking for volunteers to assist us. We wish to engage the park patrons in this activity, to be able to make informed decisions. Your ideas and opinions will be of great value as the board reviews and completes these governance documents. This is an opportunity for park patrons to contribute their knowledge and ideas for the benefit of all.

The board is forming several committees which we hope can each have both a cabin lease holder representative and a seasonal agreement holder representative, or a member of the public. There are already drafts of these governance documents which the board wishes to review with your assistance to ensure their content is logical and respectful to park patrons while addressing a variety of external regulatory requirements from various agencies. Complete new cabin lease agreement; provide initial response to queries/issues from cabin lease holders for board review

Seasonal Agreement Holder Committee:

2 board members, 1 cabin lease holder, 1 seasonal agreement holder

Complete 2023 seasonal lease agreement; provide initial response to queries/issues from seasonal agreement holders for board review; review and complete approach and procedures for move list and waiting list

Development and Improvement Committee: 2 board members, 1 cabin lease holder, 1 seasonal agreement holder

Integrate development, improvement and maintenance regulations with zoning and building by laws; initial response to queries/issues from cabin lease holders and seasonal agreement holders.

Compliance Committee:

2 board members, 1 cabin lease holder, 1 seasonal agreement holder, 1 member of the public

Develop respectful but effective means of compliance of bylaws; investigate queries/issues from cabin leaseholder, seasonal agreement holders and the public

Environment Committee:

2 board members, 1 cabin lease holder, 1 seasonal agreement holder

Environmental regulations; initial addressing of queries/issues; education projects; monitoring
