

**R.M. of Leask No. 464
EQUIPMENT TENDER**

INFORMATION FOR TENDERERS

1. Submission of Tenders

The Rural Municipality of Leask No. 464 is now accepting tenders for the purchase of one all wheel drive motor grader with the trade in of one 2014 John Deere 772G motor grader with approximately 12,668 hours.

Sealed and email tenders must be clearly marked "Grader Tender" and submitted no later than 1:00 p.m. Monday, January 9, 2023, and addressed to:

Verbal tenders will not be accepted. Tenders received later than the time specified will not be accepted regardless of the post mark date or courier delivery schedule.

2. Tender Documents

This posting includes all information required to submit a tender. Tender documents can be mailed to the R.M. of Leask No. 464 municipal office, with no claim to the RM for loss or damage to the documents once mailed. Tenders may also be emailed, with no claim to non-delivery of electronic documents once emailed.

3. Product Specification and Requirements

ALL WHEEL DRIVE MOTOR GRADER must be equipped with the minimum following specifications:

1. Front wheel assist;
2. Blade accumulators (impact system);
3. 14' Moleboard with 2' extension;
4. Between 220 – 300 horse power;
5. 17.5" x 25" Snow Plus tires;
6. Two auxiliary hydraulic valves and hoses in the front of unit;
7. Cab with climate control heat/air conditioning, AM/FM radio, 12-volt phone outlet;
8. Back up lights and camera;
9. Blue and amber beacon light for snow removal;
10. LED lighting;
11. Engine block heater;
12. Reversible fan;
13. Front and rear fenders;
14. Bottom guarding; and
15. Parts manual plus operation and maintenance manual.

*Please list specific items separately and highlight any options at or above the **minimum requirements** so that a fair and proper comparison can be made.

*Please specify your **warranty options** so that a proper comparison can be made.

*Please specify the earliest **delivery date** of the grader in the tender submission.

*Please specify available **financing** options and interest rates.

***PST and GST** applicable shall be entered in separately from unit prices.

4. Right to Accept or Reject Tenders

The tender shall be based upon the whole of the specifications and requirements without reservations. The tender must be submitted listing all standard and optional equipment as well as any other pertinent information needed for Council to make a fair comparison.

Lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. Council reserves the right to reject or accept any tender for any reason, without explanation, whether arbitrary, unreasonable, or otherwise. Decisions to request clarifications or to conduct interviews are at the sole discretion of the R.M. of Leask No. 464 Council. The earliest date of delivery may be taken into consideration when determining who to award the tender to. The successful tender will be determined and weighed at the discretion of the Council and will be based on the grader that provides the best value to the municipality

By the act of submitting a tender, the proponent waives any right to contest in any proceedings or action the right of the Municipality to award to any party in its sole and unfettered discretion.

5. Unacceptable or Unbalanced Tenders

Each item in the tender shall be a reasonable price for such item. Under no circumstance will an unbalanced tender be considered. The R.M. of Leask No. 464 Council will be the sole judge of such matters and should any tender be considered unbalanced it will be rejected.

6. Interpretation of Tender

If a prospective tenderer is in doubt as to the true meaning on any part of the specifications or requirements or finds omissions or errors, they must notify the municipal office. If an addendum or change is deemed necessary; all persons that are known to have received tender documents will receive such addendum or notice of change.

7. Increase in Quote

No claim for increase in rates on unit prices or other prices will be entertained.

8. Payment

Payment will be issued on the same day as the delivery of the grader to the R.M. of Leask No. 464 shop and upon inspection by the Superintendent of Public Works.

9. Execution of Contract

Failure by the successful bidder to meet the above requirements will entitle the R.M. of Leask No. 464 to cancel the agreement. The R.M. of Leask No. 464 may then elect to award the contract to another bidder or take such action as they choose.

10. Presentations

The Municipality is asking for your best price and all submitted information and prices at the tender opening will be the only price being accepted.
