Ducks Unlimited Canada (DUC) lands available for hay and grazing

In an ongoing effort to manage DUC-held properties as waterfowl and wildlife habitat while also assisting Saskatchewan livestock producers meet their need for adequate forage, DUC has again opened its tender process for lands to hay and graze. Each year, DUC makes roughly 75,000 acres of hay and pasture available; this includes 52 acres of hay land currently up for management in the Rural Municipality of Leask.

**The following are the individual parcels up for tender in your RM:
NW11-46-6-W3**

Considerations for bidders:

1. The tender process closes at 12 noon CST on July 11, 2024.
2. Cutting may start on or after July 15, 2024.
3. All hay must be removed from the property by October 15, 2024.
4. The bidder will leave a minimum of 4 inches of stubble on property.
5. Only one cut of hay is allowed.
6. The bidder must provide payment in full to DUC prior to cutting.
