21/26 Laberge

Motion: The OHPC Board approve the minutes of the 02 April 2026 Meeting.

OLD BUSINESS

22/26 Katarynych

Motion: The OHPC Board rescind motion 97/25 asking the RM to plow our roads in the winter when they come to due Island View and Garand Place. The Hamlet will take over the responsibility and only have it done by the RM when requested.

Motion: The OHPC Board reimburse Rene Laberge for the purchase of folding tables in the amount of \$532.72.

Motion: That the OHPC Board purchase 20 yards of road gravel and accept the quote from Big Stone Crushed Rock and Gravel for \$847.02. Five yards to be spread in garbage compound and fifteen yards held in reserve for road/parking lot maintenance. In addition, the Board requests the RM pay the invoice when received.

Motion: The OHPC Board request that the RM of Leask provide a written explanation of the issues surrounding our proposed 2026 budget, including detailed reasons the RM did not approve the requested 75% share of tax revenue. The Board is asking that the explanation include changed circumstances in the RM budget that resulted in not being approved for the requested 75% which is needed for the Hamlet to sufficiently operate. The Board is concerned that a 45% share of the tax base is inadequate to operate without utilizing reserve funds. The Board had designated the current reserve funds for significant repairs and improvements to the boat launch and area.
